



Covid-19 Protocol

In order to keep the hall safe for all users, we ask that you comply with the following protocol:

Keep away if unwell

If you or any other users have any symptoms of Covid-19, do not enter the hall. Stay at home and observe government rules.

Use the “one-way” system

Enter the hall via the Union Road entrance and exit to the High Street.

This will help reduce bunching on the narrow pavement at the front.

2 metre lines are marked at the rear

Use hand sanitiser

Touch-free sanitiser dispensers are fitted at both doors

Wear face masks

These are compulsory. This applies to everyone in the hall (over the age of 11, but if children can be encouraged to wear them, that is better)

Observe social distancing

The 2 metre rule should be applied. Even with face masks, try and maintain a safe separation.

Keep internal lobby doors propped open

This stops door handles being touched.

Test and Trace

Everyone entering the hall should record their details. This can be done via the Village Hall web site at:
